Dear Mayor Hoye and Members of the Municipal Council:

As was discussed at the December 17, 2013 meeting of the Municipal Council, the Land Court entered judgment in favor of the City on December 16, 2013. By operation of law, this judgment vests title to the property in the City of Taunton. G.L. c. 60, § 64. Johnson v. McMahon, 344 Mass. 348 (1962). Due to the numerous and longstanding code violations existing at the property, the City took immediate measures to begin clean-up of the property, particularly the areas near the front of the property that constitute an attractive nuisance and potential danger.

As was also discussed at the December 17th meeting, the law grants the former owner of the property a period of one year in which to petition the court to vacate the judgment. Please know that the former owner has in fact filed such a petition with the Court.

A hearing was held in this case at the Land Court in Boston on January 6, 2014. The Law Department submitted a lengthy and vigorous opposition to the motion to vacate. We submitted multiple affidavits, numerous photographs of the property, and reports from the Board of Health, Fire Department, Zoning Enforcement, Building Department, Police Department, and the Conservation Agent, all in opposition. We also offered the live testimony of Police Chief Edward Walsh, who has been instrumental in this case.

The judge overseeing the case is allowing the former owner a brief period of time to file additional documents with the Court. The judge also indicated that he may hold a further hearing before making a ruling on the petition to vacate.

Whether or not to grant a petition to vacate such a decree "rests largely in the discretion of the trial judge," <u>Lynch v. City of Boston</u>, 313 Mass. 478 (1943). The law considers a petition to vacate "extraordinary in nature and will be granted only after careful consideration and only where required to accomplish justice." <u>Id.</u> The Law Department informed the Court, in a manner we consider very comprehensive and thorough, that the petition to vacate should be denied.

Please know that we will continue to keep you updated as to the status of this case. Thank you, as always, for allowing us to be of service to you and the citizens of Taunton.





ANNUAL REPORT – TAUNTON, MASSACHUSETTS January 1, 2013 – December 31, 2013

This year marks the 54th anniversary of the Bristol County Mosquito Control Project and its services to the cities and towns of Bristol County. The project was established in 1959 in response to numerous cases of Eastern Equine Encephalitis. Over the years, our project has greatly reduced exposure to this arbovirus and to the newly introduced West Nile Virus.

Much has changed in recent years. New technologies and products are now available to help monitor and suppress the presence of mosquito borne diseases. Our project has embraced new innovations to help us serve the public with greater efficiency. For example, GPS guidance systems have been installed in our spray trucks. These devices enable our workers to effectively schedule and conduct early morning applications, document application routes, and tell us where "no spray zones" exist in any particular neighborhood. We have also adopted more environmentally responsible products for our larvicide and adulticide applications. We did this in order to be a better steward of the environment and reduce any unwanted effect on non-target organisms. We still continue our practice of surveillance through trapping and sending specimens to the Massachusetts Department of Health for testing.

During the 2013-mosquito season, over 28,610 mosquitoes were tested. There were 29 isolations of EEE with 6 collections from human biting mosquitoes and no human cases for the County. We had 79 mosquito isolates of WNV in the County with no reported humans. There were no equine cases for EEE and 1 for WNV.

Our project continues its efforts year round. In the Fall and Winter seasons, our goal is to reduce mosquito breeding areas through water management and source reduction. We clean and maintain drainage ditches, culverts, and streams. Where feasible, we conduct open marsh management projects in conjunction with the Army Corps of Engineers.

During the time period January 1, 2013 – December 31, 2013 the Bristol County Mosquito Control Project:

- Sprayed over 24,381.2 acres
- Treated 29.3 acres with B.t.i. and .582 acres with Altosid in 116 locations for mosquito larvae
- Received 1,404 requests for spraying
- Cleared and reclaimed 8,627 feet of brush
- Cleaned 1,545 feet of ditches by machine
- Mowed .70 acre of brush by machine
- Treated 3,530 catch basins

Throughout the year, we strive to educate the public concerning mosquito borne diseases and simple ways people can protect themselves and help prevent breeding on their own property. We have many types of outreach programs including; speaking at public health events, visiting local schools and senior centers, and creating informational posters for distribution. Our Project also has a website www.bristolcountymosquitocontrol.com to better communicate with and relate important information to our cities and towns.

I would like to thank the city officials and residents of Taunton for their continued support and cooperation. Our project is extremely proud of the work we perform and look forward to serving our communities in the upcoming year.
