Please pay accumulated benefits up to the date of retirement.

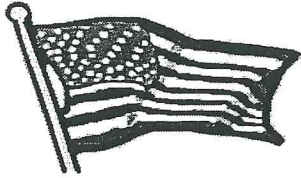
