Please be advised that a bid opening for the Star Theater Demolition project was conducted at 3pm on Thursday, March 20, 2014. The lowest responsible bidder was **JDC Demolition Company**, out of Boston, with a total bid of \$560,555. The Bid Tabulation sheet showing all bids received is attached. I have also included for your review all Bid Documents, specifications, and addenda that were issued with respect to this matter. See separate packet.

It is the intention of this office, working together with the City Law Office, to remove the Star Theater and the threat to public safety as soon as possible. All utility disconnection work should be concluded by late Wednesday, March 26th. Abatement work has been ongoing and should conclude by Monday, March 24th. An accessible pedestrian detour, fully compliant with the ADA, is already in place.

As you know, an Emergency Waiver from DCAMM was approved and this is an urgent situation. Therefore, I respectfully request approval on the Council floor for a transfer in the amount of \$635,555 from the Stabilization Account #84-145-8000 to Building Department Account #01-493-0202-5310.

Your funding approval will allow us to cover the following costs:

Dear Mr. Walkden:

Based upon review of the Demolition Contract bids, JDC Demolition Company, Inc. is the apparent low Bidder with a base bid price of \$533,555 and a total bid of \$560,555, assuming Bid Alternate #2 (Exterior Insulation Finish System) is the required finishing option for the exterior of the existing party wall. In the event that the exterior of the party wall can be prepared and bead blasted to an acceptable finish, savings of approximately \$13,800 would result. The three (3) selected Bidders were pre-qualified, based upon their DCAMM certification status and their experience with projects of similar size and complexity. All submitted bids met the submittal requirements stipulated in the bid documents, and the low bid is within 7% of the Engineer's estimate of \$500,000. Reference is made to the attached bid tabulation.

Since the low bid was submitted by a qualified Bidder and all bid submittal requirements were met, we recommend the Contract for the subject demolition project be awarded to JDC Demolition Company, Inc. The recommended contract value is <u>\$635,555</u>, broken down as follows:
