Kilton Place, Street Acceptance

Dear Mayor Hoye, and Councilors;

The DPW has a need for the acceptance of this street in order to locate a new sewer line as a replacement for an inadequate system currently in place. The work is to be completed as part of a larger sewer separation project. At the same time, improvements to water and drainage systems, as well as the pavement, can be accomplished.

The City currently maintains the roadway and utilities, but does not receive Chapter 90 credit. Acceptance of this road will allow the City to use Chapter 90 funds for this project, and will add to the city's inventory of accepted, Chapter 90 eligible streets. I recommend that the City accept Kilton Place as a public way so these improvements can be realized.

The Planning Board voted to forward a Positive recommendation for Kilton Place to be an accepted Street in the city.



RE:

Brook Street Extension Discontinuance

The Engineering Department has reviewed the petition for the discontinuance of a portion of Brook Street Extension, and has found the following:

- 1. This segment of Brook Street Extension runs between Oak Street and East Whitehill Street. Only 450 feet of the approximately 700 feet of the street is proposed to be discontinued.
- 2. The surrounding properties are, or are intended to be all owned by the proponent. Once the roadway is discontinued, ownership rights of the property will revert to them. A plan combining these lots will need to be prepared prior to any development
- 3. Access to East Whitehill Street via Brook Street Extension is currently not possible. A portion is used for parking, while the majority is undeveloped.
- 4. Access to East Whitehill Street is and will continue to be via Mineral Street.
- 5. The City maintains a sewer line on this section of Brook Street Extension. Any discontinuance should be subject to the proponent granting a utility easement to the City.
- 6. The legal description refers to a plan, but should include "Approved January 27, 1949, John F. Parker Mayor".

Based on the above, I recommend that the City discontinue this portion of Brook Street Extension as a public way, with the condition that a 20-foot (minimum) utility easement, centered on the sewer line, be granted to the City of Taunton.

Re: 3 Mill Street, Middleboro, Massachusetts - Water Main Extension

Dear Mr. Marshall:

I am working with Steven M. Kahian, the owner of 3 Mill Street. Mr. Kahian is seeking permission from the City of Taunton (the "City") to extend the water main to serve 3 Mill Street. The existing water main ends at 5 Mill Street, which directly abuts the southern boundary of 3 Mill Street and is also owed by Mr. Kahian. Currently, the 2-family residential building at 3 Mill Street is served by a well.

In 2005, Mr. Kahian received permission from the City to tie his building located at 29 Harding Street, Middleboro, into the City water main on Route 44 (Harding Street) to service his furniture business. In 2013, the City gave Mr. Kahian permission to connect to the Taunton water main on Route 44 under the 2005 approval and to extend the water line along the edge of Mill Street to 5 Mill Street. The water line installed was an 8 inch supply main that currently serves the furniture store at 29 Harding Street and 5 Mill Street.

By this letter I am respectfully requesting on behalf of Mr. Kahian permission to extend the water main approximately 100 additional feet to service the 2-family home.
