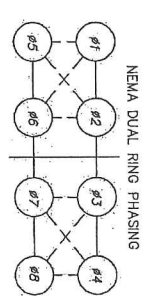
- EMERGENCY VEHICLE PREEMPTION SIGNAL SHALL BE OPTICALLY TRANSMITTED BY OPTICAL EMITTERS MOUNTED IN EMERGENCY VEHICLES AND RECEIVED BY OPTICAL DETECTORS (RECEIVERS) LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION.
- PREEMPTION SIGNALS SHALL BE SERVICED ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS.
- IN RESPONSE TO A PREEMPTION SIGNAL RECEIVED BY OPTICAL DETECTOR RECEPTION SIGNAL SHALL BE TRANSMITTED TO TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROLLER FOR A MINIMUM OF TEN (10) SECONDS OR UNTIL PREEMPTION SIGNAL CEASES. THE CONTROLLER SHALL THEN TIME THE RELEVANT CLEARANCE INTERVALS AND SERVICE THE SUBSEQUENT OPERATIONS. THE PREEMPTION SIGNAL SHALL BE REASSESSMENT SIGNALS UNTIL ALL CLEARANCE SIGNALS RESUME PROVIDED THAT ALL PREEMPTION SIGNALS HAVE CEASED.
- NORMAL VEHICLE CLEARANCES SHALL BE PROVIDED ON PHASES THAT ARE TO BE TERMINATED BY PREEMPTION DEMAND.
- PREEMPTION STROBE SHALL BE ILLUMINATED WHEREVER ANY EMERGENCY VEHICLE PREEMPTION SIGNAL IS ON.



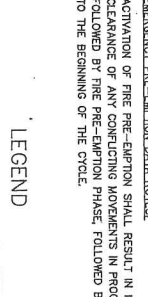

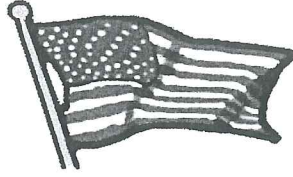
