**Order for a second reading to be ordained on a roll call vote**

Ordered That,

**\$2,100,000** is appropriated, for the purpose of paying costs related to the remodeling, reconstructing and making extraordinary repairs to the *Taunton High School Stadium, 50 Williams St, Taunton, MA*; and to meet this appropriation, \$500,000.00 will be transferred from available funds and the Treasurer with the approval of the Mayor is authorized to borrow

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\$1,600,000.00 under Chapter 44 of the General Laws; and that the Mayor is authorized to take any other action necessary or convenient to carry out this project.

FURTHER ORDERED: That the Treasurer is authorized to file an application with the appropriate officials of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts (the "Commonwealth") to qualify under Chapter 44A of the General Laws any and all bonds of the City to be issued pursuant to this Order, and to provide such information and execute such documents as such officials of the Commonwealth may require.

**Order for a second reading to be ordained on a roll call vote**

Ordered That,

**\$1,200,000** be appropriated for the cost of engineering services for the plans and specifications for improvements to the City's wastewater system and or pumping stations, consisting of the Phases 11 and 12 SSES, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto; that to meet this appropriation, the Treasurer with the approval of the Mayor is authorized to borrow **\$1,200,000** and issue bonds or notes therefor under Chapter 44 of the General Laws or any other enabling authority; and that the Mayor and any other appropriate officials of the City are authorized to take any other action necessary or convenient to carry out this project.

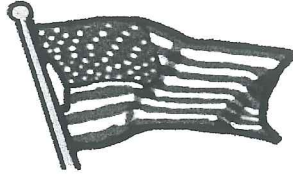
