Ordinance for a second reading to be passed to a third reading

AN ORDINANCE

Chapter 13 MOTOR VEHICLES & TRAFFIC

ARTICLE II OPERATION OF VEHICLES

Section 13.56. Speed zones designated.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Council of the City of Taunton as follows:

That Section 13-56 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Taunton, as amended, and hereby is further amended by adding thereto the following:

Special Speed Regulation No. 7915. MA DOT

Thirty-five (35) and Forty (40) miles per hour

JOSEPH E. WARNER BOULEVARD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Dighton Town Line, thence northerly on Joseph E. Warner Boulevard 1.20 miles at 45 miles per hour; 0.34 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction Route 44 (Winthrop Street); the total distance being 1.54 miles.

JOSEPH E. WARNER BOULEVARD – SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Route 44 (Winthrop Street), thence southerly on Joseph E. Warner Boulevard 0.27 miles at 35 miles per hour; 1.27 miles at 45 miles per hour ending at the Dighton Town Line; the total distance being 1.54 miles.

All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL REQUESTED I SPEAK TO THE HOME OWNER AT 1916 BAY ST. REGADING ONGOING OCCURRANCES OF MOTOR VEHICLES DRIVING OFF THE ROAD AND INTO THE YARD.

I MADE OBSERVATIONS OF CONTRIBUTING FACTORS TO THE PROBLEM. MOST IMPORTANTLY VEHICLES ARE BEING DRIVEN ON FIELD ST. TOWARDS BAY ST. AND PROCEEDING THROUGH THE STOP SIGN AND BEING INVOLVED IN CRASHES WITH OTHER VEHICLES ON BAY ST. AND OR CRASHING INTO FIXED OBJECTS IN THE YARD SUCH AS TREES.

I SPOKE TO THE RESIDENT AND EXPLAINED SEVERAL OPTIONS AND FEEL THE FOLLOWING MEASURES OF PREVENTION AND WARRANTED AND WOULD BE BENIFICIAL.

ONE LARGE YELLOW AND BLACK WARNING TWO DIRESTION LARGE ARROW [W1-7] BEING A HORIZONTAL RECTANGLE DESIGNED SPECIFALLY FOR THIS PURPOSE. THIS WOULD BE INSTALLED AT THE END OF FIELD ST. ON THE FAR SIDE OF BAY ST. FACING FIELD ST.TRAFFIC.

ALSO, AN ADVANCED TRAFFIC CONTROL SYMBOL [W 3-1A] WARNING OF A STOP SIGN AHEAD.

Dear Mayor Hoye and Members of the Municipal Council:

At a recent meeting of the Heart of Taunton/Taunton Area Chamber of Commerce, with Marilyn Green, Commissioner of Parks, Cemeteries & Public Grounds present and fully supportive, as well as leaders of various community organizations, the idea of making the *Lights On! Festival* a "closed event" was raised and discussed. Since we are working very hard to make this year's event more family friendly and affordable, it was the strong consensus of the group that it is <u>not</u> consistent with this mission to have vendors with highly priced items soliciting families and their children at this event.

Several board members from the Heart of Taunton received complaints last year that not only were families paying for buttons but many of the vendors were very aggressive in trying to attract children to purchase their costly and cheaply made wares.

Some vendors present have been unreasonable when told they are not to set their temporary carts on the Taunton Green. Partly as a result, some children have been left unattended and found running inside the protected electrical areas on the green. In addition, there have been large amounts of trash left from vendors' empty boxes - carelessly discarded on the streets and parking lots around the city area.

We are requesting that the City formally prohibit vendors from participating in this event. We are proposing that this event be a "closed" City event to vendors, and that only sanctioned vendors be allowed in certain designated areas to be determined at a later time. If we are unable to do this, then we request that all vendors be screened prior to the event and that restrictions be placed on the items sold (i.e. no silly string, cherry bombs, snappers, etc.)

Taunton's distinction as the "Christmas City" is the one true function that is open to the entire community. We do not wish to discourage the number of people participating in this event. Rather, we wish to create an atmosphere that is family friendly and affordable during these Holiday festivities.
