- 1. The meeting was called to order. A quorum was present.
- 2. Minutes of the last meeting were corrected:
  - a. The TPS School Superintendent is Dr. Julie Hacket.
  - b. BPVT, not TPS, may be able to do the old front porch.
- 3. John visited with representatives of Congressman Joseph Kennedy. He was invited to TNH and John spoke about grants for windows.
- 4. Katie Santos from BCC presented a well-attended dental care for seniors seminar to our C.N.A.s.
- 5. Red Sox Opening Day was a successful event attended by Mayor Hoye.

- 6. John will attend the Community Garden meeting at Friedman on April 25<sup>th</sup>:
- a. The city water department will tap into the fire hydrant.
- b. The Garden Club will be asked to supply the hose connections, water barrels, and trash receptacles.
- c. John will bring the agreement to them for signature.
- 7. The Board is not pleased that the driveway is in poor condition; John will follow up with DPW.
- 8. The fire hydrants were tested and are functioning.
- 9. John is working on the signs.
- 10. John is working on the curtains.
- 11. The Board approved the color for the second floor. John will commence with the painting.
- 12. John will contact Paul LeVec about the design for the front porch renovation.
- 13. John will contact the Historical Society about the renovation. Joe DeMello may be the point of contact.
- 14. Census has improved. John is attempting to balance cash, expense, and budget with June 30<sup>th</sup> as the last day of the fiscal year.
- 15. John is pursuing the CPE. This should come in prior to June 30th.
- 16. KPMG is auditing the city and they are reviewing our construction expenses as we crossed the spending threshold amount of \$ 250K. John does not foresee an issue.
- 17. Margaret Lynch, wife of Senate candidate Stephen Lynch, visited TNH. A representative of Senate candidate Markey dropped off materials.

- 18. Morton nurse practitioners have begun to visit TNH as part of the Steward ACO. Their goal is to decrease re-admissions back to Morton Hospital.
- 19. The Prime Grocer request for pricing was issued. There are four Prime Grocers eligible under the state CommPASS system:
  - a. SYSCO
  - b. US Foods
  - c. Reinhart-AGAR
  - d. Performance Foods
  - e. Responses are due by May 17th for a July 1st contract start.
- 20. A question from the Board: Is TNH insured? For how much? Is there a deductible? John will put this question in writing.
- 21. A question from the Board: Does the housekeeping employee who drove through our front fence have insurance?
- 22. John informed the Board of the two coffee spills. A discussion took place. John will wait for the DPH letter.
- 23. The next meeting is May 28<sup>th</sup>.
