- 1. The meeting was called to order.
- 2. Minutes of the December 17, 2013 meeting were approved.
- 3. The bed spread was selected. We will order 100.
- 4. The furniture was ordered with an expected delivery date of April 28th.
- 5. TNH will paint and refurbish the Business Office the weekend before the delivery.
- 6. John will send a letter to the Municipal Council for furniture disposal.
- 7. A dumpster will be brought on site for disposal.

- 8. VEOLIA turned down our request for funds to replace the toilets and faucets.
- 9. The hole in the front has been filled. Thank you Wayne Walkden.
- 10. Five of seven workers passed Serve Safe, including John.
- 11. Twelve workers passed CPR training.
- 12. TMLP will install new lights in the back of the parking lot; thank you Mr. Martin.
- 13. City Clerk Rosie Blackwell performed the Marriage Ceremony at TNH on Valentine's Day.
- 14. Red Sox Opening Day is April 4th.
- 15. John explained the dental law suit; Dr. Prohovich will be retained.
- 16. The Taunton Art Association donated more paintings.
- 17. The 1144 contract is under negotiation.
- 18. Charlie Crowley and John will discuss pictures for the Dining Rooms.
- 19. Pension expense for FY 2015 was discussed; it has not increased much.
- 20. Cash, census, and other financials eight months YTD were discussed.
- 21. John will repair the entrance walk way fence.
- 22.SYSCO will continue as our Prime Grocer.
- 23. John is proceeding with other approved capital repairs.
- 24. John is pursuing the DOE windows energy grant request of \$ 500K with Representative Kennedy and Senator Markey. The Mayor and City Solicitor will participate in meetings in Boston.
- 25. John discussed two employee accidents; the kitchen chemical event and one employee falling by the dumpster. No lost time.
- 26. The preliminary TNH FY 2015 budget was presented; the budget will be in the range of \$ 8.3M.
- 27. The Boudreau Medicaid Recovery Project was discussed; many questions must be answered before the TNH Board approves and the contract is signed. They include:
- a. How much cash will be received?
- b. How will the cash get to TNH? By RA or check? Will there be a separate RA?
- c. What will the fee be; is it based on cash recovered or RA payments?

- d. Might the Commonwealth Fiscal Pend the payment and TNH be liable for the collection contract percentage?
- e. Might this impact CPE?
- f. Might this impact future Medicaid-Medicare cost report settlements?
- g. Cash is cash and it counts in all settlements.
- h. How will the city pay the collection fee?
- i. How will that impact budget?
- 28. The Taunton Community Garden met with the Board. The Board approved the continuation of the garden in 2014. The following points were discussed:
 - a. The garden will be expanded 50%.
 - b. An underground watering system will be installed. This is subject to City Building and Water Department approval.
 - c. The fence will be expanded.
 - d. A shed will be installed.
 - e. A map was presented.
 - f. What will be the expense of the water and electric meter?
 - g. Does water use impact our sewer bills?
 - h. John noted no problems with the garden in 2013; all gardeners were good neighbors to TNH.
 - i. There is a Memorandum of Understanding for the community garden from 2013. John will send it to City Legal to review and approve with the noted additions to the size and watering system.
- 29. The next meeting is April 29th, the fifth Tuesday in the month.
