

## INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Torrington Housing Authority will receive bids for the **Willow Gardens – Site Improvements, until 1:00 p.m. on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2009**, at the Office of the Housing Authority, 110 Prospect Street, Torrington, Connecticut, 06790, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work generally consists of site demolition, pavement construction, drainage, lighting, planting and related work associated with the site improvements.

The Bid Document may be obtained at said Office of the Housing Authority, - on or after **12:00 noon on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2009 for a non-refundable payment of \$25.00 per set**. Bid documents will be available for public review at the Office of the Torrington Housing Authority, 110 Prospect Street, Torrington, CT 06790.

The Housing Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids or any part of a bid presented, as its interest may appear.

Attention of bidders is directed to certain requirements of this contract which require payment of Davis-Bacon wages, and compliance with certain local, state and federal requirements. This is a federally funded project. All sureties for bids must be listed on the most recent IRS Circular 570.

All bids will be considered valid for a period of 90 days.

A **non-mandatory** pre-bid conference shall be held at **1:00 p.m., on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2009** at **Willow Gardens**, Torrington, CT.

The Contractor shall comply with the Copeland Anti-Kickback Act and Regulations of the Secretary of Labor (29 CFR, Part 3).
