2. Replace all the Federal Wage Rate pages in bid documents Section 8 with the following updated 10 day Federal Wage Rates pages attached dated May 13, 2011.
3. Replace page I-2, Information For Bidders Checklist with the following revised page. (Line 'H' should read "page Section 7-1").

Add the following paragraph, number 2.03 C, to Technical Specifications, Section 16500, Exterior Lighting: **The Lumec product line is RN20-90W49LED4K-ACDR-LE2R-VOLT-USA-CRAT-[M-001]-PH7/VOLT-BKTX.** An electrical transition box shall be supplied and installed that is manufactured specifically for use with required bracket. Transition box will give access to the wiring and ground connection. This will be complete with a watertight connector, 90 degrees, including adapter to ¾" steel conduit riser.
7. Add the following paragraph, number 1.02 B, subparagraph #6 to Technical Specifications, Section 16000, **GENERAL ELECTRICAL, TELEPHONE AND CATV:**

Electrical service work to condominium building includes supplying and installing a three (3) inch galvanized rigid steel riser from hand hole including sweep to proposed weatherproof steel enclosure to be located adjacent to existing weatherhead. CL&P will provide wire for new riser from hand hole to proposed weatherproof steel enclosure. The contractor shall remove the existing weatherhead and provide splice within steel enclosure and terminate conductors. The enclosure and steel conduit shall be grounded via the existing electrical service per NEC.250.122. Contractor shall coordinate with CL&P and building owners for the disconnection and reconnection of power supply. The existing condominium main switch is 250 volt fuses. Electrical service work at Church building shall include supplying and installing complete galvanized rigid steel or schedule 80 PVC conduit (size and material to match existing conduit) from hand hole including sweep to existing underground service conduit including connection of existing and new conduit and wire splice.
