## Landfill Solar Project Addendum #1

Pre-Bid Conference  
Questions & Answers  
March 14, 2012; 2 PM

### 1. What is the acreage of the hazardous waste site?

The cleared solid waste landfill area is approximately 19 to 21 acres. In addition to this area, there are 3 acres located within the fenced area noted as the metal hydroxide disposal area. The solid waste area and metal hydroxide site can only be used given Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) approval. The entire site including the tree area is approximately 99 acres.

### 2. How will the City proceed if Virtual Net Metering is not approved in 2012?

The City wishes to select a developer shortly after receipt of proposals and finalize an agreement that allows submittal to Connecticut Light and Power Company's (CL&P's) ZREC solicitation program this year. It appears that proposed virtual net metering bill amendments allowing a lease agreement is moving forward in the State Legislature. The City is committed to working with the selected developer even if an agreement is not reached before CL&P's RFP submittal deadline. It is anticipated that CL&P's RFP will be advertized sometime in mid April 2012 possibly open for up to eight weeks. PURA will release their final decision on CL&P's RFP ZREC package on March 28, 2012. **The RFP opening date and time will not be extended.**

### 2. Is one (1) Mega Watt the largest system that will be allowed?

If a larger system is economically feasible, then the City is agreeable to a larger system. The Connecticut Public Utility Regulatory Agency (PURA) will direct CL&P to provide bid proposals based on nameplate rating; however, the maximum project capacity solicitation will be limited to 1 MW for ZRECs and 2 MW for LRECs and projects will only receive RECs for the project's actual energy production. Project RECs exceeding the program caps can be used at the customer's discretion outside the ZREC and LREC programs. In addition to this information, "Virtual Net Metering" will have a nameplate capacity rating of two megawatts or less.

### 3. What is the power demand for the City of Torrington?

The attached list shows the history of the City's five highest electric accounts.

### 4. Will crossing the railroad and state highway with aerial power lines require an easement?

The railroad is State owned. Connecticut Department of Transportation (CDOT) rail division approval will be required to run aerial lines over the tracks. I confirmed with the local CDOT District office that they will issue a permit to cross over the State's South Main Street highway right of way. Also, the narrow strip of land between the South Main Street highway right of way and the Naugatuck River is currently owned by Ted Marola. Approximately 5 years we had talked to Mr. Marola about

obtaining an easement to install a sewer line from the highway through this same property and under the river to the sewer plant. At that time Mr. Marola was open to granting an easement.

**5. What is the point of interconnection with the power grid?**

We do not know the answer to this question. Further review and discussions with CL&P is required.

**6. Who owns the power lines entering the landfill property?**

The overhead lines/poles that are on Vista Drive are under CL&P's ownership. Also, a copy of CL&P's pole data base that we have in our office indicates the poles located within the landfill site, located adjacent to the gravel access drive, are CL&P poles and the poles are numbered.

**7. Can the lease bid be tied to ZREC and can the suggested ZREC be a fixed amount?**

For Proposal comparison purposes the ZREC credit shall be assumed to be \$250. The City wants to be able to compare "apples with apples" and limit the variables in the proposals.

**8. Can poles be inserted in to the landfill cap?**

No, the cap cannot be penetrated with poles, footings, conduits, fence posts or equipment. Any disturbance to the grass surface during construction activities will have to be reestablished to prevent erosion of the cap.

**9. Can maps be included in the addendum in a PDF format?**

PDF files of available mapping if given in the original RFP package.

**10. Is there as venting or collection system in-place for the landfill?**

No.

**11. Can a detail of the landfill cap be included with the addendum?**

Attached are two original details of the cap sections.

**12. What DEEP permitting will be required as part of this project?**

The City has written a letter to the DEEP Commissioner asking if a DEEP permit is required. We have not received a response yet.

**13. What are the costs to the developer payable to the City of Torrington?**

The Zoning/Inland Wetlands application fee will be approximately \$210. The Building Department fee will be approximately \$25.26 for the first \$1,000 of the project cost plus \$12.26 for every thousand dollars thereafter. The Building Department has a \$150 plan review fee.

**14. What are the City of Torrington's insurance requirements?**

Attached is an Accord certificate sample specifying insurance requirements.

**15. Who will be responsible for grounds maintenance?**

The Proposer/developer will be responsible for all maintenance adjacent and between their solar panels. If the area is fenced by the developer, then all maintenance within the fenced area will be the responsibility of developer. The City will maintain the existing access road and adjacent areas outside the panel area. The City will maintain the access drive gate. The City will entertain any other security systems the developer may want to propose. The City will be using the access drive to dispose of clean fill on a periodic basis in the clean fill area designated on the attached map showing this area.

**16. Is the developer required to fence in the area of the system?**

Fencing is not required; however the developer will be responsible for security. Fence posts cannot penetrate the cap.

**17. Can the field meeting sign in-sheet be included with the Addendum?**

Attached is the attendee sign-in sheet for the site meeting.

**18. Who is responsible if contaminants are encountered?**

Prior to beginning work the developer shall inspect site with City to verify cover conditions and if any contaminants are exposed. If so the City will be responsible for cover repairs. Any contaminants exposed during construction shall be the developers responsible to remedy.

**19. Will taxes have to be paid to the City?**

Yes, property taxes on equipment will have to be paid to the City Tax Collector. Torrington has a private Tax Collector. Also, sales taxes are not exempt.

**Below are responses to additional questions the City's Purchasing Agent received from companies regarding the RFP. Some of the questions were asked again in the field meeting and were not repeated and are answered above.**

- a. Perspective companies can visit the site by requesting permission to enter the property by contacting the Engineering Department. The City will unlock the gate for entry that day.
- b. Is there an engineer's estimate for the project?  
No.
- c. Is there a transformer bank which services the facility?  
No.
- d. The Inlands Wetland Commission mentioned in the RFP; is this a City, County or State agency?  
It is a local City commission.
- e. Regarding the Alternate Proposal of connecting to the Water Pollution Control Plant, will the successful party be required to dismantle the electrical lines after the 15 year PPA contract expires? Also, will the supply lines to the Water Pollution Plant need to be buried for the sections that traverse the sewer plant site?  
All equipment and infrastructure installed by the developer will have to be removed at the end of the 15 year lease term except if there is a mutual agreement to extend the lease agreement and project terms. The supply wires to the Water Pollution Control Plant within the sewer plant property do not have to be buried.
- f. Is there a bid bond required for this project?  
No bid bond is required however there will be some type of financial instrument required for removing the equipment at the end of the lease term unless negotiated otherwise.

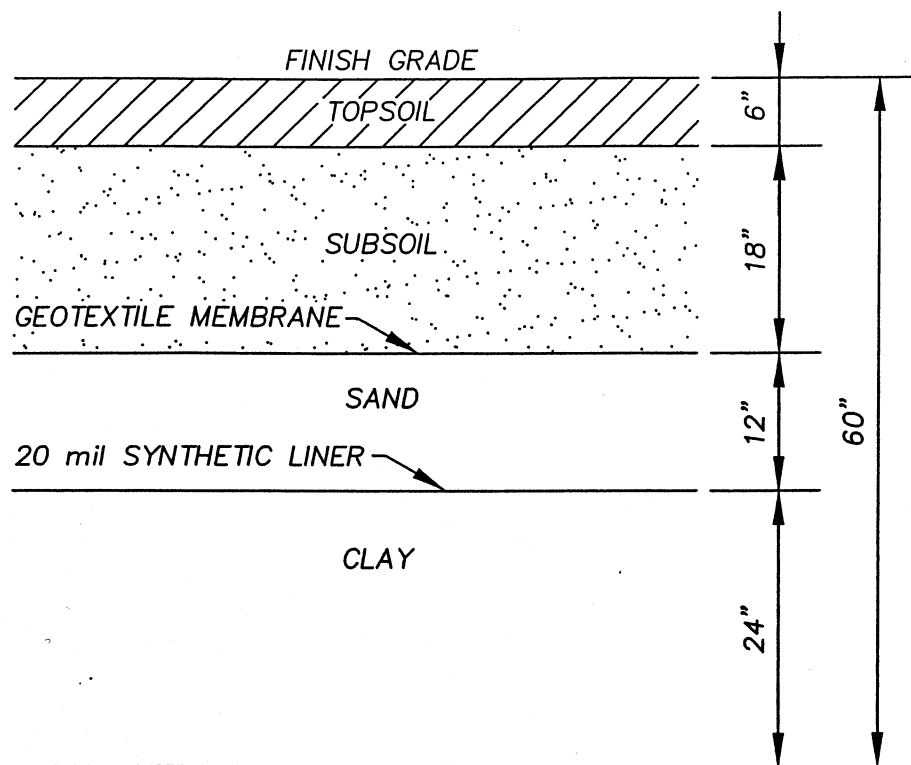

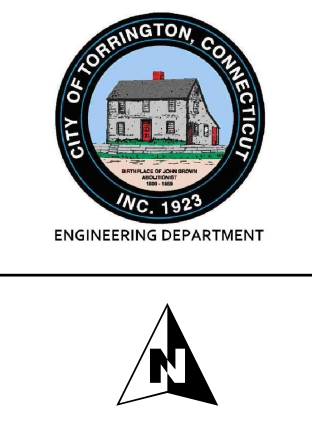
