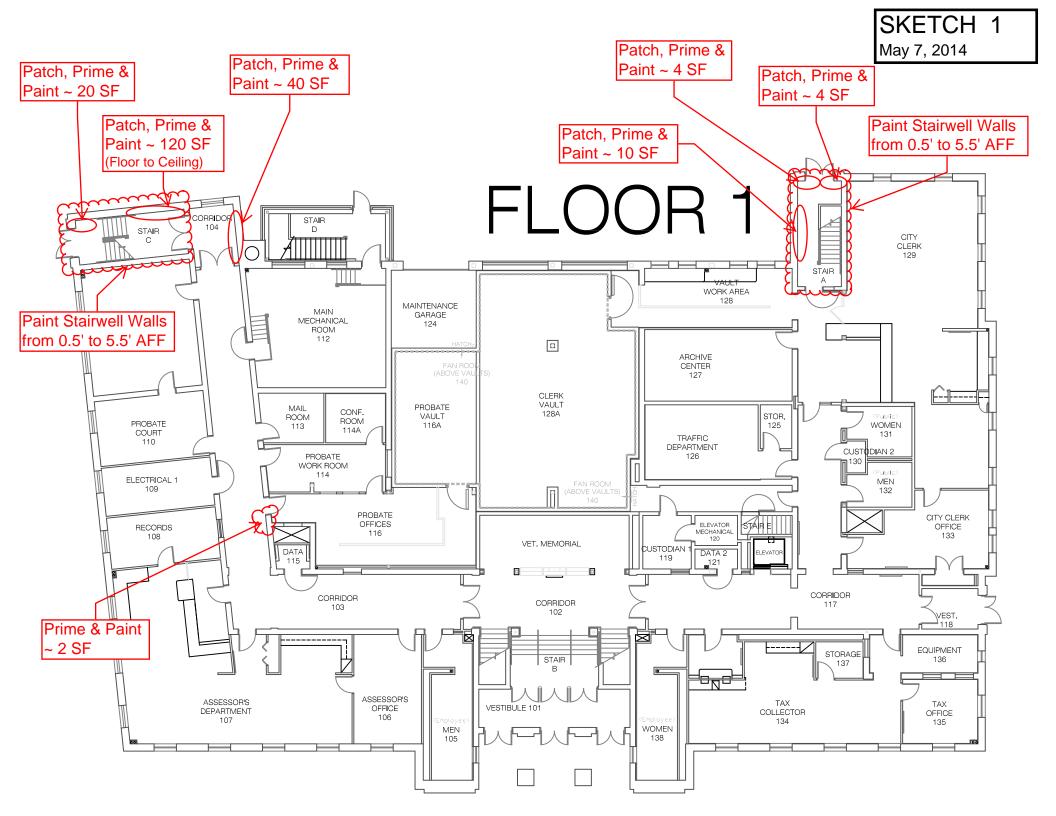

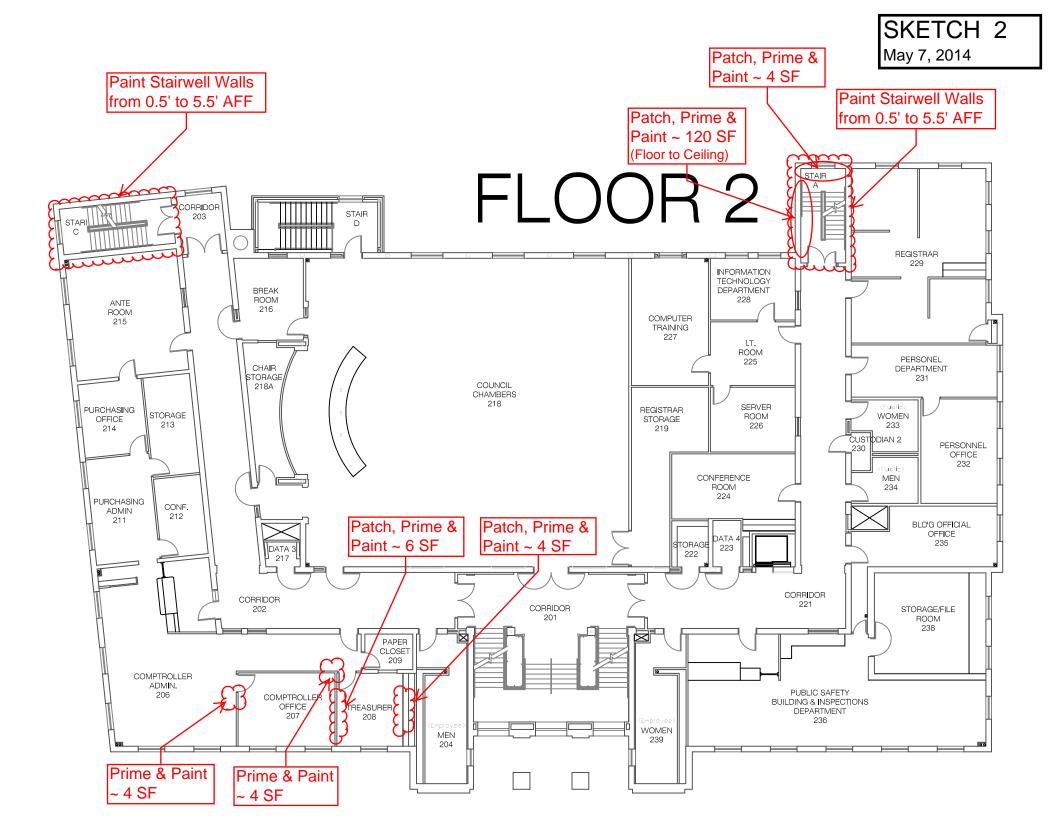

TORRINGTON CITY HALL REPAIR & PAINTING OF MISCELLANEOUS AREAS May 21, 2014

Repair and painting of approximately 340 square feet of damaged walls and painting of approximately 2,000 square feet of walls at Torrington City Hall, 140 Main Street, Torrington as shown in Sketches 1, 2, 3 & 4 attached. The following is an outline of the scope of work. Bidders shall note any recommendations and/or deviations from this outline with their price quote.

- Inquires and/or site visits can be made during normal City Hall working hours.
- Barricade and close stairways while work is being performed with signage (inside and outside of building) directing employees and public to use alternate entrances. Only one stairwell/entrance shall be closed at a time.
- Protect all floors and surfaces not identified for painting with painters tape and dropcloths.
- Inspect job site to verify condition of all walls in area of proposed work and notify Public Works Director of any discrepancies in work requirements.
- Obtain paint chips from typical areas to be painted including stairwells, corridors and office walls (two colors) for paint matching.
- Obtain adequate product as required to complete all work and submit Product Data Sheets and MSDS Sheets for all paint purchases.
- Scrap, sand and removal of all loose paint and plaster in noted areas.
- Patch holes, depressions, etc. in walls with plaster wall patch or approved filler to provide smooth and suitable surface for painting.
- Sand patched areas until filled area is level with surrounding areas.
- Prime one coat all areas patched.
- Paint two coats of top color with paint to match.
- Materials shall match existing surfaces and be equal to:
 - o Primer will be equal to Sherwin Williams ProMar 200 Zero VOC Latex Primer B28W02600.
 - Stairwell, Corridor Walls and Office Walls Paint shall be equal to Sherwin Williams ProMar 200 Zero VOC Interior Latex Eg-Shel B20-2600.
 - Ceilings will be equal to Sherwin Williams ProMar 200 Zero VOC Interior Latex Flat B30-2600.
- A broom-clean surface of the entire area is required at the end of each workday. Removal of all materials and cleanup shall be performed daily.
- One un-opened gallon of paint for each color used shall be left with the city for future touchups.
