ADDENDUM NO. 1

To be considered as part of the contract drawings and specifications for the EAST BASIN SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT: BID #EBS-041-053016, dated May 2016.

QUESTIONS

Q1. *Please advise if there is an addendum to change the bid date.*

A1: The bid opening shall take place May 31, 2016 at 11:30 a.m. (see below)

Q2. *Will only CT minority firms be allowed or can we use subs certified in other states too?*

A2: DBE Firms shall be certified in accordance with Section 00830-B, Clean Water Fund Memorandum (see Article VI, Acceptable Certification Options, on page 2 of 4).

Q3. *Measure & Pay Section 01270 Bid Item 1a. Is this item to pay for all the clean & TV of the pipe to be lined? If so, will the quantity be changed? If not, is the pipe in this bid item to be cleaned & not lined?*

A3: All pipe reaches to be cleaned, tested, inspected, and sealed are shown on the drawings and included in tables labeled "Clean and Test Joints."

Q4. *Measure & Pay Section 01270 Bid Items 2a to 2e. This does not say that the clean & TV of these lines to be incidental to the lining. Where does the clean & TV of the pipe to be lined get paid?*

A4: Cleaning prior to and TV inspection after installation of the liner shall be considered incidental to the installation of the liner and shall not be separately measured for payment.

Q5. *Measure & Pay Section 01270 Bid Item 4a. There is a separate bid item for cutting protruding services but it is all said to be incidental to the CIPP lining. Where is the payment for the cutting of protruding services to be carried?*

A5: Cutting protruding services shall be measured per service and paid for under Item 4a, Cut Protruding Services.

Q6. *Measure & Pay Section 01270 paragraph 1.05.B. There is currently no bid item for grouting of service connections. Will a bid item for this be added or will the grouting of service connections be deleted? IS this incidental to the CIPP Lining Bid Items?*

A6: Grouting of services shall not be separately measured for payment and shall be considered incidental to the installation of the liner.

Q7. Please verify that the pipe lining on Plan C5 is 12" as shown, not 8". Quantities on the bid tab would reflect that they are 8" not 12".

A7 The Form of General Bid has been updated (see below and attached).

Q8. Is there a site in the city where we can dispose the pipe cleaning debris?

A8: Pipe cleaning debris can be brought to the Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) located on Bogue Road, Harwinton, Connecticut.

Q9. Will we be able to access the hydrants in the City for water use for the project?

A9: Water will be able to be obtained from fire hydrants with red tops or at the WWTP. The Contractor shall coordinate with the Torrington Water Company for use of hydrants.

Q10. The plans show locations where Uniformed Officers will be needed for Traffic control. Some of these areas are State Roads, others are Local. In locations outside of this listing the Contractor will use Certified flaggers. However there is no Separation of Bid Items for Uniformed Traffic Officer vs Flagger which is how the billing will differentiate. It is also only "payable by the Invoiced amount" rather than the dollar value entered into that Bid Item.

This arrangement will skew the Bid totals and have no direct correlation to the actual work. Will the owner consider changing Bid Items 6a & 6b to an Allowance for Traffic men and an Allowance for Flaggers? Alternatively will the owner consider changing Bid Items 6a & 6b to designate between Flaggers and Uniformed Officers rather than between State and Local Roads?

A10. The Contractor shall coordinate with the City of Torrington Police Department to determine the required number of officers and/or flaggers. The Form of General Bid has been modified (see below).

Q11. Will the owner locate and if necessary uncover all the manholes associated with this project?

A11. Yes.

Q12. Many of the easements appear to be located adjacent to wetlands. Are the appropriate permits already acquired for work in the easements? Will the owner clear and stabilize easements where necessary to allow access to the manholes on the project site?

A12. The Owner has obtained Inlands Wetlands Permits. See specification section 00890, Permits. Clearing and grubbing shall be completed by the Contractor in accordance with Section 02230 and shall not be separately measured for payment, but shall be considered incidental to the project.

Q13. Will the owner restore easements where necessary?

A13. No. The Contractor shall restore all areas disturbed by the Work. Surface restoration shall not be separately measured for payment, but shall be considered incidental to the project.

SPECIFICATIONS

SECTION 00100, ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Delete the first paragraph on page 00100-1 in its entirety and insert the following in its place:

Sealed bids for construction of the East Basin Sewer Rehabilitation Project for the City of Torrington, CT will be received at the Office of the City Purchasing Agent, City Hall, 140 Main Street, Room 206, Torrington, CT, until 11:30 AM, on May 31, 2016. Bids received after the date and time specified will be rejected. In the event of the closure of City Hall, the bid will be opened at 11:30 AM on the following business day that City Hall is opened.

SECTION 00410, FORM OF GENERAL BID

Delete page 00410-3 through 00410-5 in their entirety and insert the attached pages in their place.

SECTION 01270, MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Delete Item 1.03.A.3 in its entirety and insert the following in its place:

Work required to prepare the pipe for lining, including cleaning shall be considered incidental to the work and shall not be measured separately for payment.

Delete 1.05.B.1 and 2 in their entirety and insert the following in their place:

1. The work of this item shall not be separately measured for payment and shall be considered incidental to the installation of the liner.
2. Services shall be grouted in accordance with Section 02443, SERVICE CONNECTION REHABILITATION.

Add the following Item 1.18 after Item 1.17, Warranty Information:

1.18 CLEARING AND GRUBBING

The work of this section shall not be separately measured for payment, but shall be considered incidental to the project.

DRAWING G-1, ABBREVIATIONS, NOTES AND LEGEND

Delete the table title "Uniformed Officers for Traffic Control" and insert "Uniformed Officers or Flagmen for Traffic Control" in its place.

DRAWING C-1, SUBBASIN 1 REHABILITATION LOCATION PLAN AND TABLES

Under the CIPP table, delete the line "TOTAL: 5,378 LF" and replace with "TOTAL: 7,984 LF"
