There shall be an additional 4 Concrete Planters provided for the 4 Plaza Light Pole Foundations Only under the Base Bid. If the City selects Bid Alternate – Ornamental Plaza Lights, the additional 4 Concrete Planters will not be required and should be deducted when preparing price for this Bid Alternate.

R4: Weather permitting it is anticipated that this project will commence Winter 2017.

Q5: Please clarify who is responsible for materials testing, as there are some conflicting statements in the specs, also frequency. Cast in place concrete, Bituminous concrete, soils compaction.

R5: The City shall be responsible for all testing requirements.

Q6: Please confirm the number of concrete planters is 8 as shown on plan, not 12 as stated in the specs.
