**CLARIFICATION REQUEST SUBMITTED ON 11/1/2012** @ **5:01 PM:** It is our understanding that this RFQ is just that - a request for Qualifications, not for a proposal, and no cost information is to be included. However, Appendix B is an Acceptance of Terms of this Agreement and includes language that any additional costs are deemed to have been included in the prices. Is this a mistake? How could a firm accept those terms for a qualifications submittal that does not include any fee information at all? It looks like an attachment to a contract, not to an RFQ.

**ANSWER:** As this is in fact an RFQ and not an RFP, the city is not accepting formal proposals and/or entering into a binding agreement with any firm at this stage in the process. Therefore, Appendix B: "Acceptance of Terms of this Agreement" is not warranted and is not required to be submitted.
