CLARIFICATIONS

You must be a plan holder who has purchased a set from the town to bid this project. You must have attended and signed-in at the mandatory pre-bid walk through on site to bid this project.

The existing activities room will remain occupied and in use during normal business hours from 8am -5 pm; The contractor shall maintain strict dust control and coordinate work activities with the owner.

Other toilet facilities are available to the users while these are being worked-on. Both bathrooms may be worked on simultaneously.

Normal operation hours of the facility are 8am -5pm Monday –Friday. The contractors are also permitted to work before and after these hours and on weekends and must coordinate this with the owner upon award of the contract.

Fixture mounting heights change from the existing, even when the fixture is located at the same horizontal dimension in the room. See the drawings for the new fixture mounting heights.

Contractors may come between 8-5 on Monday –Friday to see the area of work again before bid day, Contact Joel Sekorski at 860-482-4151 to arrange this.

Building Department Fees will be waived, but the State Fees of \$0.26/\$1,000 must still be paid by the Contractor.

Dumpsters shall be located in the rear parking lot during construction, (the side toward the river).

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

1.2 SUMMARY

1.3 DEFINITIONS

- A. Alternate: An amount proposed by bidders and stated on the Bid Form for certain work defined in the Bidding Requirements that may be added to or deducted from the Base Bid amount if Owner decides to accept a corresponding change either in the amount of construction to be completed or in the products, materials, equipment, systems, or installation methods described in the Contract Documents.
 - 1. The cost or credit for each alternate is the net addition to or deduction from the Contract Sum to incorporate alternate into the Work. No other adjustments are made to the Contract Sum.

1.4 PROCEDURES

- A. Coordination: Modify or adjust affected adjacent work as necessary to completely integrate work of the alternate into Project.
 - 1. Include as part of each alternate, miscellaneous devices, accessory objects, and similar items incidental to or required for a complete installation whether or not indicated as part of alternate.
- B. Notification: Immediately following award of the Contract, notify each party involved, in writing, of the status of each alternate. Indicate if alternates have been accepted, rejected, or deferred for later consideration. Include a complete description of negotiated modifications to alternates.
- C. Execute accepted alternates under the same conditions as other work of the Contract.
- D. Schedule: A Schedule of Alternates is included at the end of this Section. Specification Sections referenced in schedule contain requirements for materials necessary to achieve the work described under each alternate.


