- 1. The vehicle must comply with all applicable N.F.P.A. Standards including 1901-99 and 1911-96.
- 2. The body will be a rear walk-in with an overall length not to exceed 20 feet and will be constructed of aluminum.
- 3. The unit will have an air conditioning systems that will cool both the front and rear personnel compartments.
- 4. The unit will have appropriate interior lighting to allow personnel to work in the unit without eye strain. The lighting system will include:

- a. Front warning lights
- b. Rear warning lights, both lower and upper
- c. Side warning lights, both lower & upper
- d. Strobe power supplies
- 5. The vehicle will be equipped with 2 Siren Speakers
- 6. A 25KW Onan generator will be included
- 7. Amkus hydraulic equipment shall be included
- 8. A minimum GWVR of 33000 lbs.
- 9. The vehicle shall have a diesel engine
- 10. An Allison Automatic transmission shall be provided.
- 11. Vendors shall include sales literature showing pictures and specifications of their proposed vehicle with their budgetary proposals.
