

**Minutes**  
**Coe Memorial Park Committee**  
**April 15, 2015**

Lori Chiron moved to request that Superintendent Simmons forward information on the Rain Garden solution to Chairman Marc Trivella for informational review at the next meeting. 2nd by Mary Zbell. Motion passed unanimously.

Margaret Keywan moved to eliminate the garden in front of the boulder in order that the dedication be visible. 2nd by Lori Chiron. Motion passed unanimously.

Mark McEachern moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:44P.M. 2nd by Mary Zbell. Motion passed unanimously and meeting adjourned.
