a. Applicant: Aldi, Inc

Location: 320 East Elm Street

Proposal: Store Expansion, façade improvements, new mechanicals to

include HVAC and refrigeration, lighting (100% LED), new

signage and paint.

Bruno Lourenco and William Turrell, Aldi, Inc. were present along with Douglas J. Levey, Senior Architect, APD Engineering & Architecture, PLLC, to discuss a 2,839 sq ft addition to provide an additional store aisle at the Aldi Store, 320 East Elm Street. The store expansion includes façade improvements, new mechanicals, to include HVAC and refrigeration, new lighting (100% LED), new signage and paint. The Committee reviewed plans titled, "Aldi Inc. Torrington, CT, 320 E Elm Street, Torrington, Connecticut," Sheets SP-1 – SP-3, LL-1, by BL Companies, dated 7/18/16; Exterior Elevations titled, "Aldi Inc. Torrington, CT, 320 E Elm Street, Torrington, CT 06790, Litchfield County," by APD Engineering & Architecture, PLLC, dated 9/4/14 revised 4/221/16. Samples of the exterior materials were reviewed. The existing roof will be replaced with a more energy efficient white roof. The exterior lighting will be LED, full cut-off fixtures. The Committee recommended that the street address be placed on the front glass entryway. Motion made by Mrs. Boe, 2nd by Mr. Mileti, to make a favorable recommendation on the project to the Planning & Zoning Commission. Motion carried unanimously.
