1. <u>Call To Order:</u>

2. Roll Call and Announcement:

4. Old Business:

a. Applicant: NJR Construction, LLC Location: 3600 Winsted Road

Activity Excavation, filling, grading within regulated area to construct

a contractor's office and workshop

Jason Dismukes, civil engineer for NJR Constructions LLC appeared before the Commission. Mr. Dismukes gave a presentation of the proposed contractor office and workshop, referring to site maps.

Drainage, sheet flow, etc. of the water and run off was explained by Mr. Dismukes, referring to maps. A level spreader is proposed on site.

Ms. Malanca presented her findings of the site review, and there are no other comments from Engineering or her. Findings of the Torrington Area Health District were briefly discussed, Mr. Dismukes noting the reserve area on the map.

MOTION by Ms. Bakker to APPROVE the application from NJR Construction, LLC at 3600 Winsted Road excavation, filling, grading within regulated area to construct a contractor's office and workshop within a regulated area, seconded by Mr. Storti, unanimously carried.

b. Applicant: The Torrington Water Company

Location: Reserve Way, Assessor Map 214 Block 002 Lot 018

Proposal: Construct 220' x 10' wide access road to proposed water tank within

regulated area.

Ms. Malanca is awaiting additional requested information from the Water Company. Ms. Malanca spoke with Jonathan Zeiner this morning, and surveyors and engineers have been back to the site, and the Water Company is awaiting those plans.

Ms. Malanca recommended tabling to the January meeting, and it still falls within the proper timing guidelines. If the information is not available at the January meeting, a request for time extension can be made.
