b. Site Plan 1185

Applicant: Chon Escobar

Location: 910 East Main Street / 23 Crestwood Road Proposal: Outdoor dining patio at existing restaurant

c. Special Exception 16-305 and Site Plan 1178

Applicant: Greenstone, LLC Location: 70 North Street

Proposal: Special Exception for storage of more than 100 cubic yards of

earth materials; and site plan for vehicle parking and equipment storage outside of enclosed structure (public hearing closed)

This public hearing was closed at the April 27, 2016 Commission meeting.

Mr. Connor read his memo dated May 2, 2016 to the Commission. It was the consensus of the Commission that this use will likely be a short term situation, as the parking lot will be needed once the new Courthouse is open and the former Torrington Company headquarters is repurposed.

Commissioner Summers indicated the Special Exception permit is valid for only two years and needs to be renewed, in the case of any violations.

Applicant: Greenstone, LLC Location: 70 North Street

Proposal: Special Exception for storage of more than 100 cubic yards of earth

materials; and site plan for vehicle parking and equipment storage outside

of enclosed structure

with the following conditions/recommendation:

- 1. Per the recommendation of Matt Walsh, P.E., Deputy City Engineer indicated in an email memo to the City Planner dated 2/22/16:
 - a. The applicant should store all earthen materials in accordance with the 2002 CT erosion and sedimentation guidelines to ensure that materials stored on site do not enter into the onsite storm water drainage system which discharges to the City of Torrington drainage system.
 - b. Silt Sacks should be installed in all drainage structures on site down gradient from where earthen materials are to be stockpiled.
- 2. The applicant shall notify the Zoning Enforcement Office of when the crushing will be taking place and the crushing cannot occur on weekends or holidays and must be between 9am 5pm for a 3 day period no more than once per year. The crushing shall be done in the north side of the lot. Fugitive dust shall be controlled during any crushing activities.
- 3. No sandblasting of vehicles and equipment shall take place outside of a building.
- 4. No firewood shall be stored, split, cut or offered for sale on the premises.
- 5. It is recommended the applicant follow the advice of Fire Chief Gary Brunoli, in his letter to the City Planner dated, 2/16/16.
