Mr. Calkins questioned why the GB zone is included in this proposal, when there is a 15 acre minimum, and the possibility of the ZBA varying the regulation in such a case. Mr. Connor stated lots could be put together, but the Commission would probably want such GB land used in a different fashion.

Mr. Polland and Mr. Herbst were agreeable to modify their proposal to eliminate the GB zone from their proposal.

Discussion followed on age restrictions, etc.

Mr. Connor reviewed his memo dated October 3, 2008 to the Commission.
