Proposal: Install additional 30,000 gallon propane storage tank

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Mr. Davis noted there was a typo on the application, the correct number of gallons is 36,000.

Mr. Calkins inquired about the outcome of the discussion regarding the pipes under the accessway. Mr. Connor read a letter from Todd Parsons of Lenard Engineering (#160) with photographs attached. The City's Engineering Department will review Mr. Parson's submission, and there will be a condition of approval regarding this matter.

1. Per the recommendation of Assistant City Engineer, Ed Scoville, P.E.L.S., the second propane tank shall include appropriate fencing. The applicant's engineer shall inspect the existing twin culverts on Harris Drive and submit a report to the City Engineering office as to the adequacy of these culverts to support the expected vehicular traffic for the propane storage facility.

2. The Fire Marshal's office shall inspect the propane storage tank for compliance with Life Safety Code prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy.

Location: 725 Klug Hill Road

Proposal: Wind Turbine (set public hearing date)

Mr. Connor reviewed his memo dated 5/13/09 to the Commission. (#763) Mr. Connor outlined various items the Commission should request from the applicant for presentation. A balloon or crane test is suggested to show the height and location of the turbine, the Planning

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and Zoning Commission shall be informed of the dates of the test. The applicant shall submit photographs of the tower imposed on the photograph, with the tower height established in reference to a balloon flown to the proposed height of the tower. View representation shall be in color and shall include preconstruction photographs and accurate post construction simulations of the height and width of the facility, i.e. superimpositions of the width facility onto photographs of existing review, etc. (#840) The places where the view representations will be taken will be determined at the next Planning and Zoning Commission meeting, staff will make recommendations.
