1. <u>Call to Order:</u> Chairman Calkins called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., Sullivan Senior Center, Shuffleboard Room, 88 East Albert Street, Torrington, CT

2. <u>Attendance/Announcement by Chairman:</u>

Chairman Calkins announced present and serving on the Commission this evening will be Greg Mele, Paul Summers, Greg Perosino, Christine Mele, Donna Greco, and Richard Calkins. Also present is City Planner Martin Connor.

Mr. Calkins announced that the 62nd annual Connecticut Federation of Planning and Zoning Agencies is having their annual conference on Thursday, March 18, 2010. Commissioner Perosino will receive an award for 12 years of service.

MOTION by Mr. Perosino to approve the 1/13/10 minutes, seconded by Mr. Mele, motion carried. Mr. Summers abstained from voting.

4. Old Business:

a. Site Plan 966

Applicant: Drakeville Volunteer Fire Department Inc.

Location: 1349 Marshall Lake Road

Proposal: 42'9" x 18' addition to firehouse (apparatus bay)

Chief Mike Maccalous appeared before the Commission and reviewed the proposed addition. Landscaping recommendations were reviewed.

Mr. Connor reviewed his memo to the Commission dated February 6, 2010.

MOTION by Mr. Mele to APPROVE Site Plan 966

Applicant: Drakeville Volunteer Fire Department

Location: 1349 Marshall Lake Road

Proposal: 42' 9" x 18' addition to firehouse (apparatus bay)

with the following conditions:

- 1. The applicant shall plant 3 street trees as indicated in a memo from Kim Barbieri, CZ&WEO, to the City Planner, dated 1/28/10, as well follow the recommended measures to prevent erosion and sedimentation to the nearby brook.
- 2. The applicant shall obtain approval from the TAHD prior to issuance of a Zoning Permit for the addition.
- 3. A Flood Plain Permit shall be obtained prior to issuance of a Zoning Permit on the project.
- 4. It is recommended that the applicant follow the advice of Fire Chief John B. Field Jr. contained in a letter dated 12/28/09 to the City Planner.

- b. Jason Vincent, Planimetrics: Discuss Torrington Incentive Housing Zone Project with Planning and Zoning Commission

Jason Vincent, AICP, Planimetrics, appeared before the Commission and explained the Torrington Incentive Housing Zone Project. Planimetrics has worked with Milone and McBroom on this project. A draft Incentive Housing Zone Report dated 2/9/10 was discussed and given to Commission Members. (#375) Overlay zones were explained by Mr. Vincent

Mr. Connor explained this will add more pedestrian traffic to the downtown. Per Mr. Vincent, these sites will have the capacity for 250 housing units, which at \$2,000 per unit and could quality for up to \$500,000 from the State of Connecticut as a zone adoption payment. An addition \$2,000 per multifamily or \$5,000 per single family unit could be paid by the State as a building permit payment to the City for building permits issued within five years of Incentive Housing Zone adoption.

Mr. Connor noted younger people aged 25 - 34 have been leaving the State of Connecticut, one of the reasons being housing costs. Mr. Connor provided details of how this overlay zone would work.

The Commission thanked Mr. Vincent for the presentation.

Applicant: Northwest Gymnastics Location: 2936 Winsted Road

Proposal: Construct 4,975 sq. ft. gymnasium and 25% reduction in required parking

- 2. The applicant shall submit a bond estimate to be reviewed and approved by the City Planner for the proposed landscaping. A bond in a form acceptable to the Corporation Counsel shall be posted prior to issuance of the Zoning Permit. 25% of the posted landscaping bond shall remain in place for one year after the landscaping plan has been fully implemented to ensure successful growth of the plantings.
- 3. A Flood Plain Permit shall be obtained prior to issuance of a Zoning Permit on the project.
- 4. The applicant shall file for a Sewer Discharge Permit prior to issuance of a Zoning Permit and pay a Sewer Connection Fee prior to issuance of a C/O.
- 5. It is recommended that the applicant follow the advice of Fire Chief John B. Field Jr. contained in a letter dated 12/28/09 to the City Planner.
