1. <u>Call to Order:</u> Chairman Calkins called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m., Torrington City Hall Council Chambers, Room 218, 140 Main Street, Torrington, CT

2. Attendance/Announcement by Chairman:

Chairman Calkins announced present and serving on the Commission this evening will be Greg Mele, Greg Perosino, Paul Summers, Christine Mele and Richard Calkins. Also present is City Planner Martin Connor, AICP.

Mr. Calkins announced to the audience that the public hearing for Rick's Auto Parts will not be held this evening.

3. <u>Minutes for Approval:</u>

MOTION by Mr. Perosino to approve the 2-9-11 minutes, seconded by Mr. Summers, motion carried.

4. Old Business:

a. Site Plan 995

Applicant: Angelo Alduini, Jr. Location: 51 Brewer Street

Proposal: 50' x 45' metal storage building

The applicant requested this matter be tabled this evening, and granted a 65 day extension. Engineering issues are still being addressed.

MOTION by Mr. Summers to table the application, seconded by Mr. Perosino, unanimously carried.

5. New Business:

a. Special Exception 11-255 and Site Plan 998

Applicant: Rick's Auto Parts Inc.
Location: 32 Ricciardone Avenue

Proposal: Creation of parking lot in R-6 Zone (Set public hearing date)

b. Special Exception 11-257

Applicant: Wingstang Realty, LLC Location: 95 Turner Avenue

Proposal: Change of use to office (former warehouse space)

c. Informal Discussion - Hrica Associates, LLC

Location: 294 South Main Street Topic: Building Addition

Kenneth Hrica of Hrica Associates appeared before the Commission. 294 South Main Street is Johnson Gas, BP. A small addition is needed to sell coffee and cigarettes. The building is in an R6 zone, which is a non-conforming use, which could be expanded by ten percent. Mr. Johnson is willing to add more green space and landscaping. Mr. Hrica provided details, Mr. Connor believed this will greatly enhance the property. Mr. Hrica pointed out details on the map in response to questions from Mr. Calkins. Mr. Connor stated this is the non-conforming section, Section 5.12, page 65. Mr. Calkins did not see a problem with using the area of the canopy towards the square footage of the building, to provide the square footage necessary for a 10 percent increase.

During this preliminary discussion, the Commission considered the square footage of both structures, the building and the separate canopy, to come up with the ten percent amount of allowable increase. Mr. Calkins noted the regs read "a structure may be increased by ten percent". Mr. Connor added this will be a Special Exception, public hearing. Mr. Perosino stated the wording should be more clear in the regulations. Fencing and grass areas were discussed.

Mr. McMorrow presented maps for review. This is a 1.9 acre parcel, the front portion of the parcel on East Main Street is zoned R6 and the back portion of the parcel is zoned R10s. They are requesting the back portion of the parcel be changed to R6 zone. Presentation followed.

Mr. Connor reviewed his March 3, 2011 memo to the Commission.

Martin Sikowski, adjoining property owner, appeared in favor of the proposal.
