Minutes of Special Meeting

Wednesday, July 21, 2010

Chairperson Patricia Fairchild called to order a special meeting of the Parks and Recreation Commission on Wednesday, July 21, 2010, at 6:00 P.M. at the Armory. In attendance were Commissioners Dan Lovallo, Duke Wall, Jim Pescatore, and Superintendent Brett Simmons.

Superintendent Simmons updated the commission on the sign hanging at Fuessenich Park which advertised The Washington Agency. Commissioners voiced concern with the placement of this sign on the front fence as all signs in the past had been placed in the outfield fence. The P 38's also had a sign which Superintendent Simmons asked to have removed and only put up during a P38 game.

Superintendent Simmons distributed copies of the Titans' contract to the commissioners. There was no specific sign policy listed in the contract, so the Titans were unaware that all signs needed to be placed along the outfield fence.

Commissioner Wall made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Lovallo that the sign by the Washington Agency be taken down immediately. Voting in favor of the motion was Commissioner Wall and voting to oppose were Commissioners Lovallo and Pescatore.

The commission will work with Superintendent Simmons to create a comprehensive sign policy to avoid future confusion by users of our parks and facilities. Commissioners are asked to email Brett with possible ideas as stated in the handouts that he distributed.
