TORRINGTON CT – November 18, 2015 – The City of Torrington Parks & Recreation Department will hold their annual Light Up Main Event on Friday, November 27th beginning at 4:00PM at Coe Memorial Park. The event will include music by Vin Avallone, performances by the Torrington Middle & Torrington High School Choir groups and a reading of a Christmas story to children by the Mayor. The Parks & Recreation Commission will be serving hot chocolate and popcorn to attendees in the park.

The North End Community Tree Lighting will take place on Thursday, December 3th at the Torrington Police Department. The event will include a selection of holiday music prior to the tree lighting. The event will begin at 5:00PM with refreshments served after the lighting.
