SEPTEMBER 20, 2016 TOWNSEND ENERGY COMMITTEE MINUTES

- 1. Call the meeting to order: Chairman Carney called the meeting to order at 7:10pm. Present were Brent Carney (BC), Kathy Thompson (KT), and Michael Brown (MB). Also present were Prospective Energy Committee Member Ron Montgomery (RM) and Land Use Coordinator Karen Chapman (KC).
