Harbor Shoreland Zone Areas within 250 feet, horizontal distance, of the shoreline, <u>including those</u> <u>additional adjacent areas as approved by majority vote at Town Meeting</u>, where the existing predominant pattern is a mixture of maritime and non-maritime uses and commercial and residential uses.
 - 4. Commercial Fishery/Maritime Activity Shoreland Zone (CFMA Zone) Areas within 250 feet, horizontal distance, of the shoreline, *including those additional adjacent areas as approved by majority vote at Town Meeting*, where the existing predominant pattern of development is commercial fishing and other maritime activities and contains areas which are suitable for functionally water-dependent uses.
 - 5. Limited Residential Shoreland Zone Areas within 250 feet, horizontal distance, of the shoreline, including those additional adjacent areas as approved by majority vote at Town Meeting, on

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shoreline of water bodies and wetlands where the existing pattern of development is low density residential with some home occupation.
