1. CALL TO ORDER

2. ROLL CALL

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made by Selectman Scott Grierson, with second by Selectman Chris Eaton, to appoint Heidi Farley to the Cemetery Committee for a 5 year term (see attached). Motion passed 5 - 0.

Motion made by Selectman Chris Eaton, with second by Selectman Kathi Thurston, to appoint Phil Worden to the Comprehensive Plan Committee for a 5 year term (see attached). Motion passed 4-1. Selectman Scott Grierson was against.

D. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN CARRY FORWARD

The Comprehensive Plan Committee has requested their balance be carried forward for the Hancock County Planning Commission's bill for their work on the Comprehensive Plan (see attached).

Motion made by Selectman Chris Eaton, with second by Chairman Charlie Dillon, to carry forward the unexpended balance towards the 2008 – 2009 budget. Motion passed 5 - 0.

7. OLD BUSINESS

A. REPORT OF ONGOING PROJECTS

- 1. NEW TOWN OFFICE: Town Manager Millard Billings met with Ken Peterson of Brookside Technologies on June 3 to look at the facility and make a recommendation. He has not completed the estimate yet. He is suggesting four mikes at the counter with mute buttons, two mikes in the audience, and two cameras. One camera pointed at the audience, the other at the Selectmen. Town Manager Billings felt the Recording Secretary could run the control station that would be over by the chair tree and elevator. We will also get the equipment to copy the digital recording to a DVD.
- 2. SALT/SAND BUILDING: Nothing new to report
- 3. SEAL COVE RAMP: Nothing new to report
- 4. FLAT IRON ROAD: Two of the three pins that give distances on the deed have been located. We are still looking for the third. Mike Avery with CES has all the information we could provide. He will check with DOT.

- 5. PLOWING AND SANDING: Nothing new to report
- 6. SEAL COVE FISHWAY: Roland Dupree visited Seal Cove Pond on June 4, 2008 with engineers. They walked from the bridge to above the new dam site. They saw at least 10 pools with from one to two fish to one hundred fish in them. The New Farm Bill for 2009 has Whip Funding only for agriculture or non commercial forestry projects. The 2008 Whip Funding has money available but the application deadline is July 3, 2008. Mr. Dupree will try to submit an application before the deadline. Because the deadline for filing the application is before the next Selectmen's Meeting, Town Manager Billings requested the Select Board authorize him to sign the Whip application on behalf of the town.

Motion made by Selectman Scott Grierson, with second by Selectman Chris Eaton, to give the Town Manager that said duty. Motion passed 5 - 0.
