## BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

November 14, 2013

- 1 The meeting was called to order at 7:17pm. Chairman Brochu opened the meeting and discussed
- the fact that the Board was present at the Board of Health's meeting to discuss two issues at the request of that Board.

## DISCUSSION ITEMS:

*Discuss Common Victualler Licensure*

8 Mr. Holman of the Board of Health explained to all present that he believes that a Common Victualler license is in fact double taxation and that the reasoning behind having such a license is 9 no longer as important as it once was. He noted that the Board of Health charges \$125 to issue a 10 food permit, and that he didn't think it was reasonable to charge businesses a further \$50 for a 11 Common Victualler license. He suggested that a better approach might be to add into the food 12 permit process some of the elements of a Common Victualler license and charge only the amount 13 of the food permit. Selectman Brochu responded that he believes that a Common Victualler 14 license is focused on the business aspects of an establishment. Such requirements include a 15 safety/code inspection, confirming taxes are paid, and that a business has proper insurance. A 16 discussion ensued on these points between the members of both boards. Chairman Desjardins of 17 the Board of Health suggested that a motion be made on the topic, to which Selectman Fleming 18 suggested that it was not in order to do so, since a decision as to whether to have a Common 19 Victualler license rested with the Board of Selectmen. Both Boards then decided to take no 20 21 action on the matter.

## 23 Discuss Animal Control Officer/Dog Officer

The second reason for the meeting was to discuss the sharing of the cost of this position. 24 Historically it has been funded through the Board of Health in the budget. The Board of Health 25 indicated that they are doing research as to the hours/week required of the job to perform Animal 26 Control and Animal Inspector duties, but that did not include Dog Officer. The Board of 27 Selectmen responded that there hasn't been a need for Dog Officer services in recent years, but 28 that if there were, they could approach the Finance Committee for a transfer. The Board of 29 30 Health agreed to keep the Selectmen apprised of the process to fill this position working with the Town Manager. 31
