The Mendon Board of Selectmen welcomed the Upton Selectmen and Town Manager to discuss the logistics associated with a possible district wide meeting about the MURSD school budget. Ms. Robinson gave an overview of the items that need to be addressed if the meeting takes place in Upton at one of the school facilities. She told the Boards that she is in contact with the chairman of the State Moderator's Association for a list of possible candidates for both boards to consider. She also reviewed the logistics that our public safety personnel are concerned about if a large number of voters attend. These include traffic control, parking, the number of detail officers needed, school bus routes to ferry passengers, locations of EMS personnel and mutual aid. Selectmen Ammendolia indicated that he has requested names of potential moderators from State Rep. John Fernandes and he suggested that the Upton Selectmen make the same request to Rep. Peterson. The boards also discussed the timing of the Mendon Special Town Meeting and the district wide meeting should it be necessary. Mendon intends to vote tonight to hold the special town meeting on September 20<sup>th</sup>. If the outcome of that meeting is not favorable to appropriating additional school funding, the MURSD School Committee will post a warrant for the district wide meeting to take place in early to mid-October. Both boards agreed that a joint Selectmen's meeting should be held on Monday, September 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 PM in conjunction with Mendon's Selectmen's meeting. Both boards will provide each other with background on the moderator's proposed. Ms. Robinson also suggested that a meeting of the school committee members coordinating the district wide meeting and relevant staff take place soon so that logistics can be coordinated among the towns.
