Cemetery Commission Minutes for 04/17/15

Meeting called to order at 6:08 PM with all members present.

Eagle Scout candidate Brochu presented preliminary plans for his proposed project to refurbish all the signs on ways throughout the facility.

A notice did appear in Town Crier for April 3, 2014 but not in April 16th. As requested. As a counter measure, UCTV will post this notice for the remainder of the period through May 6th.

Board reviewed a collection of town ledger books passed on from Town Clerk. Though interesting these documents have no value to the commission at this time.

On motion of Glenn Fowler, with unanimous vote of the board, these documents will be offered and delivered to the Historical Commission as soon as possible.

DPW advises they now have four or five plaques for veterans who have passed recently. The Commission will mark proper location and the DPW will place these plaques as time permits.

Glenn Fowler reviewed his recent meeting with the Massachusetts Cemetery Association for the other members of the board.

Commissioner McMann will be out of town for a couple of weeks and has delivered the Cemetery Commission phone to Robert Richard for the duration of his absence.

Discussion continues regarding appropriate fees for Cemetery lots and services. Glenn Fowler will meet with our new DPW Director as soon as possible to outline a best estimate of actual annual operating costs for the ongoing operation of each of the four facilities now being managed. He will report his findings to the board at the next scheduled meeting following establishment of the facts.
