The minutes of the 9/18/2012 meetings were edited and approved.

Treasurer's Report - The General Account = \$ 985. The gift account = \$3,414.60 \$ 2, 554. not earmarked for landscaping.

Tyler Bartlett gave us an update on the shed construction. He will begin his fundraising. Tyler said we will need a building permit (no cost). Construction will begin the construction in the Spring. The Selectmen gave Tyler a \$ 500 donation for the materials. The total cost = \$ 2,400.

Website – New web site is now up . Howard Glassman has been working on it . Jon and Howard are working on the photos . The UHC will decide which photos are used .

Metacomet – Jon discussed the CR for Heritage Park with Mike Penko. Mike said they were onboard. They need to perform a site survey; they hope to get that done in November. Cathy thought the language in the purposes section of the CR should be stronger.

Cemetery- The First Cemetery is under our control. Maureen will talk to Mike Penko about spraying. Bradish Cemetry is in rough shape. DPW needs to be made aware of the issue. Maureen will get an estimate for the tree removal in First Cemetery. CPC funds? Prisoners helping?

Fencing - George met with Miller Fence for an estimate . Other options are being discussed as well.

OSL - Cathy received a 12 page report on the containments. The scientists believe the containments issue has been resolved. NEARA may be helping us with the cost of the additional testing. We have \$ 400 now from contributions specifically for testing.

Plantings – We should start planning for Spring of 2013 for planting.

Men's Club – Maureen to ask them again for fencing . \$ 1,000 would be a good starting point.

Rotary Club – We need to request for a grant.

Mendon Lion's - Joyce will follow up for help with handicap accessible walking paths.

Local Cultural Council- Cathy will be working on the possibility of a grant
