  - Question of whether OS Comm is interested in pursuing land purchase/grants. Possibly try to get buy-in from Affordable Housing Comm. or Recreation Comm. Note that there is no Affordable Housing Comm.
  - BT will get on CPC meeting agenda for November to discuss and gauge their input. Get grant for appraisal if interested.
  - Possibly could purchase for affordable housing using CPC affordable house money develop as an Open Space development. Ask CPC if could use affordable housing money for this. Sell development rights to developer. Sell frontage lot to defer cost.
