Minutes of the Uxbridge Board of Health meeting held on Wednesday, November 18, 2015 at 5:00 pm in the Selectmen's Meeting Room, 21 S. Main Street, Uxbridge, MA:

Present: Wayne Tucker, Chairman, Jonathan Neitz, Member, Michael Morrissette, Member. Also present, Kristin Black, Health Agent and Denise Delannoy, Administrative Assistant.

Absent: None

Meeting to order: The time being after 5:00 pm and the meeting duly posted with a quorum present Chairman Tucker called the meeting to order.

Residents' concerns: No one present.

Old Business: Russell McClean, Industrial Foundry Corp. 91 Elmdale Road, requests a three month extension to their Order to Correct dated 11/27/2015. Mr. McClean advises that the company is working with Clean Harbors and the DEP in applying for a pre-application for a Special Use Permit. The pre-application takes approximately one month and the application process takes another two months. Therefore, they will not be able to complete the removal in the time allotted by the Order to Correct.

Kristin Black, Health Agent concurs with Mr. McClean and informs the Board of the progress at 91 Elmdale Road.

Motion by Jonathan Neitz to extend the Order to Correct, for three months, for the Industrial Foundry Corp., 91 Elmdale Rd. Seconded by Wayne Tucker, and the motion carried unanimously.

Old Business: Winona Boucher, requests a variance to Article XVII Regulations for the Land Application of Organic Material to apply bio solids to hay field at 685 Chocolog Road due to weather/time constraints.

Discussion, MA State regulations vs. Town of Uxbridge regulations, the Casella manufacturing process, DEP approval of suitability.

Motion by Jonathan Neitz to grant the variance for the property/field at 685 Chocolog Rd. Seconded by Michael Morrissette. Wayne Tucker abstained.

Special Conditions of variance for 685 Chocolog Road Biosolid application as follows:

- 1) Applicant shall use only Biosolid fertilizers classified as US EPA Class A, Exceptional Quality (EQ).
- 2) Product shall have a Massachusetts Type 1 Approval of Suitability.

- 3) Product shall be applied in strict accordance with federal, state, municipal and manufacturer's guidelines and regulations including maintaining required setbacks from water resources.
- 4) Applicant shall provide detailed product information and proposed application rates.
- 5) Applications shall not exceed recommended application rates.

New Business:

Kristin Black, Health Agent – Discussion: Motel Regulations and changes that are necessary in order to cover the towns cost to provide Motel inspections and permitting.
