Minutes of the Uxbridge Board of Health meeting held on Thursday, July 16, 2009 at 9:00 am in the Lower Town Hall meeting room, 21 South Main Street, Uxbridge, MA

Present: Chairman Susan Smith, and James Smith, Member. Also present, Denise Delannoy, Administrative Assistant.

Call to Order: Being after 9:00 AM the meeting having been duly posted, and a quorum being present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith.

New Business:

Mark Anderson, Heritage Design Group and Leonard Fournier and Jack, Bernat Mills Complex, The group came before the Board to discuss adopting guidelines enabling Bio Tech companies to do business in the Town of Uxbridge.

Appoint Thomas Rice as an agent for the Board of Health,

MOTION: James Smith moved to appoint Thomas Rice as an Agent for the Uxbridge Board of Health. Susan Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. There will be no monetary compensation for a period of thirty days but, Mr. Rice shall be able to recoup his expenses.

Rescind Board of Health Article XXV, Prohibition on Installation of Outdoor Wood Boilers and Outdoor Wood Furnaces,

MOTION: James Smith moves to rescind Board of Health Article XXV, Prohibition on Installation of Outdoor Wood Boilers and Outdoor Wood Furnaces and adopt State of Mass Regulations 310 CMR 7.26 (50) Outdoor Hydronic Heaters. Susan Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Permitting and Inspection of Outdoor Wood Boilers,

MOTION: James Smith moved that the Board establish a permit for the occasion of an installation of an outdoor wood burning furnace that shall include a plot plan locating the outdoor wood boiler with appropriate setbacks from surrounded structures, and appropriate chimney height clearly marked. The permit will also include an inspection. The fee will be determined at a future meeting.
