OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Bassett Cemetery# 4/Rockmeadow Road Extension: Nothing new to report. Sheryl to discuss matter with new Town Manager, Sean Hendrick.
- 2. Update on Accounts & Trust Funds' Balances: Account balances are based from the end of August 2011, and all stated figures are correct.
- Signs for Cemeteries: For those cemeteries which still need to have their historic signs
 placed at the entrances: All signs are ready for placement, but the hot & humid weather
 has stalled this work. Community volunteer will undertake work in the fall season. The
 12 signs and posts will be placed by the volunteer, with Sheryl and husband, Harry,
 overseeing the work.
- 3. Starrett monument still in storage area at Uxbridge Highway Department; getting this moved to Farnum House and into the cellar requires heavy lifting and navigation through the bulkhead entrance to cellar.
- 4. Buffum Cemetery #25: Mary's lawnmower needs repair/replacement and currently unable to mow cemetery grounds. Motion made by Beth, to have Chris Cotta mow Buffum Cemetery grounds for a final mowing of the season, if Mary is unable to get the mowing done. Seconded by Roy. Unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Community Service Day at Uxbridge High School: All day, Thursday, October 20th, high school students will volunteer their services for community needs. Quaker City Cemetery#23, 50 Providence Street has been chosen as the site for clean-up of leaves and brush by the volunteering students. Jill and husband Frank, will oversee the work. Jill to let committee members know at next meeting if a borrowed truck will be available for transport of leaves/brush to Town's compost site.

- 2. Blackstone Valley Cemetery Network: The Blackstone Valley Heritage Corridor has established a collaborative of local groups involved in historical cemetery preservation, with the first meeting held on Sept. 16, 2011. The group defined its role as having two purposes: a.) to foster discussion of issues and ideas specifically related to repair, maintenance, and restoration of cemeteries; b.) to conduct group projects that are specifically related to repair, maintenance and restoration of cemeteries. Their next meeting is scheduled for Thursday evening, October 27, 2011 in Woonsocket, RI. Sheryl plans on attending with BetsyYoungsma (of Douglas).
