Director's report - Marsha is working on a revised supplemental budget. The Massachusetts College of Pharmacy will hold a class at the center to inform people how to use the computer to obtain accurate, contemporary medical and health information from the internet.

Marsha received a letter from Tri Valley that they intend to hand out to the people who come to lunch at the center. They ask for our input. Our recommendation is that they should not send it out. The letter insinuates that Tri Valley is not at fault.

Elderly Connection report – The February Valentine Tea was a great success with over 60 people attending. Peter DiBatista reported that our share of the Glamarama program last October was \$396.86. We co-sponsored the program with the Uxbridge Lions Club.

We have a plot at the Community Gardens. We will need volunteers to make it bear fruit and vegetables for our lunch program. Donna was able to obtain 200 free seed packets from the URI Outreach Program.
