#### Meeting Postings:

- \* Except in an emergency, a public body must post notice of a meeting at least 48 hours in advance, excluding Saturday's, Sunday's and legal holidays, except in emergencies.

  \* "Emergency" is a sudden, generally unexpected occurrence or set of circumstances demanding immediate action.
- In an emergency, a public body shall post notice as soon as reasonably possible prior to a meeting.
- Notice must include date, time and place of meeting.
- Must include listing of topics the chair reasonably antidpates will be discussed at the meeting.
- Topics must give enough specificity so that the public will understand what will be discussed.
- Public bodies are encouraged to update the notice when aware of new topic within the 48 hour period before the meeting
- Chairs should not post notices so far in advance that there is a high likelihood that new topics will arise, wless the chair updates the notice with an such new topics 48 hours in advance of the meeting.
