NEW BUSINESS

Public Hearings:

- RDA FY11-07 – Uxbridge DPW on Quaker Highway, Route 146A – Proposes to install approximately 5,000 linear feet of 20-inch diameter water main in Quaker Highway (Route 146A) to connect the new Rosenfeld Pump Station to the Town's existing distribution system at Crownshield Avenue.
- DEP #312-9xx, NOI, Flagg RV, 865 Quaker Highway (Map 50, Parcel 4024) – Construction of a corner of an impervious parking area, well, utilities & stormwater management basin (including a spillway weir) to collect & discharge stormwater runoff resulting from the construction of 2 buildings, the remainder of the proposed parking areas & access driveway located outside of the 100' buffer zone.
- DEP #312-9xx, NOI, 3P Properties, LLC, 52 Commerce Drive (Map 40, Parcel 3725) – The proposed project involves installation of ground mount solar panels & associated utility connections within the buffer zone of the bordering vegetated wetland.
