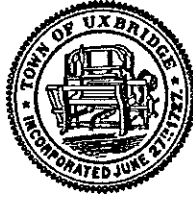

NEW BUSINESS

Public Hearings:

- RDA FY12-02, River Road Roadway Maintenance Work – The proposed project consists of scarifying & reshaping existing gravel road, grading & placement of additional granular material as needed along the gravel section.
- DEP #312-919, Request for Amended Order of Conditions, BSC Group on behalf of Uxbridge High School & Uxbridge School Building Committee on 246 -270 Quaker Hwy (Map 36, Parcels 4474, 2784, 3645 & 3534) – The proponent requests an Amendment to the Order of Conditions. During the construction of the associated forced sewer line, the presence of bedrock ledge required shifting the line 15-20 feet to the west of the previously approved route in one location.
- DEP#312-931, NOI, ExxonMobil Pipeline Company on Ironstone Street (Map 45, Parcels 3831 & 3946) - The proposed project involves polymer wrapping of existing petroleum pipeline.

Meeting Postings:

- \* Except in an emergency, a public body must post notice of a meeting at least 48 hours in advance, excluding Saturday's, Sunday's and legal holidays, except in emergencies.
- \* "Emergency" is a sudden, generally unexpected occurrence or set of circumstances demanding immediate action.
- \* In an emergency, a public body shall post notice as soon as reasonably possible prior to a meeting.
- \* Notice must include date, time and place of meeting.
- \* Must include listing of topics the chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed at the meeting.
- \* Topics must give enough specificity so that the public will understand what will be discussed.
- \* Public bodies are encouraged to update the notice when aware of new topic within the 48 hour period before the meeting.
- \* Chairs should not post notices so far in advance that there is a high likelihood that new topics will arise, unless the chair updates the notice with on such new topics 48 hours in advance of the meeting.
