


DEP #312-916, Request for Amended Order of Conditions, Triumvirate Environmental Inc., 146 Mendon St (Map 19, Parcel 3621) - The proponent requests an Amendment to the Order of Conditions for a remediation construction status update and a deconstruction sequence update. Due to unanticipated amount of mobile no. 6 fuel oil entering the soil excavation during site dewatering activities, this has caused a delay in the excavation and live loading of petroleum contaminated soil.
