February 17, 2014

Meeting opened by Acting Chairman Faye McCloskey at 3:20 PM in the Uxbridge Town Hall.

Present: Roy Henry, William Albin, Peter Emrick, Shirley Maynard, Faye McCloskey and Mary Dolan. Absent: J. Francis Cove.

Secretary's report was submitted and motion to accept was made by Shirley Maynard seconded by William Albin. It was pointed out our minutes of the November 19 meeting have not been read to date and will be done at our March meeting.

Immediate conversation was on our inability to enter the Cornet John 'Farnum House because snow on the walk was at least 2 to 3 ft high. Members agreed not shoveling the walk is a problem should emergency entry be required and problem needs to be resolved before any more storms (hopefully in 2015). Parking lot was plowed and in good condition.

Secretary read a request from Peter Waugh seeking permission to allow 16 to 18 members of Cub Scout Pack 25 Den F an escorted tour of the Cornet John Farnum House in March. Definite date to be decided with the Uxbridge Historical Society President, Roger Poulin. Motion to accept made by Peter Emrick, seconded by Shirley Maynard.

Faye McCloskey noted Unibank is replacing the new electric sign with a wood sign which is more in keeping with the historic District in which the bank "resides" Unibank directors were most cooperative and the Town is grateful to all.
