The Town Manager asked Francis Cove to submit the total cost for all the repairs needed to restore the entire Cornet John Farnum House for the Capital Planning Committee that will meet on January 4th. Francis Cove will meet with the builders, again, to review and go over the costs because there was a discrepancy in the price and the work that would be done.

New Business:

Faye McCloskey, Chairman of the Uxbridge Historic District Commission, explained that the Commission would like to extend the Historic District on North Main Street, Mendon Street, Capron Street and the South Uxbridge Ironstone Schoolhouse. A motion was made by Francis Cove to support the Uxbridge Historic District Commission Committee's desire to extend the Historic District from 55 North Main Street to Homeward Ave.; from 52 North Main Street to Hazel Street; from 8 Capron Street to the end, including the McCloskey School; from 89 Mendon Street to West River Road up to Patrick Henry Street, and the Ironstone Schoolhouse on Ironstone Street in South Uxbridge.

It was seconded by Roy Henry and passed unanimously.
