UHDC minutes from 16 Nov 2016 meeting

Meeting commenced at 5:35 pm in lower town hall. Members present were Marion Baker, Melissa Haskell, Jane Keegan, Faye McCloskey, and alternate Michael Cove.

Members absent: Travis Baker, alternate Eric Belseth

Minutes read by Melissa Haskell, motion to accept the minutes as read by Faye McCloskey, seconded by Marion Baker. Unanimous response in favor of accepting minutes, *from Oct. 2016 meeting.*

Old business:

Letter to property owners was discussed. Letter was edited and corrections were made. Motion was made to accept the letter to property owners by Marion Baker and seconded by Melissa Haskell. The motion passed unanimously.

New business:

Motion to accept new business out of order was made by Jane Keegan, seconded by Melissa Haskell, unanimous vote in favor.

Chief Kessler came to discuss the brick masonry for the new fire station, when the mock wall would be available to view. Meeting was scheduled for Dec 5 at noon to view the mock wall.

Motion made by Melissa Haskell and seconded by Marion Baker to approve a sign for Mark Wickstrom on Court St. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussed the possibility of extending the Historic District north on North Main St up to Hazel St. The process to add additional buildings into the District was discussed. Motion was made by Jane Keegan to seek to extend the Historic District north from 47 North Main St to the junction of North Main St and Hazel St. The motion was seconded by Faye McCloskey and passed unanimously.

A motion was made to include the Ironstone School in South Uxbridge into the Historic District by Faye McCloskey and seconded by Jane Keegan. The motion passed unanimously.

No other business came before the commission.

Next meeting scheduled for 14 Dec 2016 at 5:30pm in Lower Town Hall. Motion made to adjourn by Faye McCloskey, seconded by Melissa Haskell, unanimous vote taken to adjourn meeting at 6:17pm.
