<u>Fire Escape update- Motion made</u> by J. Karagosian, 2nd by E. Kroll to pay \$2400.00 out of Trust Funds of Library expenses for the Preliminary engineering study of the fire escape. No votes in favor of this motion, **Motion was defeated.**

Bartro, to ask the Capital Planning Committee to expend the necessary funds for the preliminary engineering study of the fire escape since the care, maintenance and support of the library building was accepted by the town in 1893 in order to ensure the continued safety of our staff and patrons, Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by M. Murray, 2nd by J. Lynch, Because of the significant amount of tax dollars involved and the scope of the project to update the heating system from oil to gas, the board requests a formal RFP and competitive bidding process. **Motion passed unanimously**
