1. Downtown Traffic: Sergeant MacDonald will monitor traffic. Chief Lourie will look into a Pedestrian Safety Grant to see if signage is an option.
2. Carney Street: Curve Ahead sign to be put up per Benn Sherman.
3. Rt. 122 Water Main Project: Chief Lourie is requesting that Ludlow Construction do night work if possible once the project reaches South Main Street.
4. Request For Streetlight: Chief Lourie expressed interest in a light at the Uxbridge District Court. That is a state highway. Benn Sherman to reach out to the MassDOT District 3 office.
5. Route 146 at Lackey Dam Road: Chief Kessler stated that the water on the highway does not properly drain during rain and snow events. Benn Sherman mentioned that the state will be doing roadway improvements on the median in that area. Benn will send a letter to the state.




6. OLV 5K: Our Lady of The Valley wants to have a 5K in April. Further details to follow to address the committee.

IV. ADJOURNMENT


Motion by Mr. Kessler adjourned the meeting at 10:50 a.m. Motion carried 5-0-0.




