Enclosed for processing are the following budget transfer and commitment for the Guaranteed Maximum Price Contract (GMP) to be considered at the March 30th, 2011 SBC and BOS meetings.

SUMMARY

The statutory "Trade Contractor" bid opening occurred on March 17, 2011 at the Uxbridge Town Hall. The total of the Trade bids exceeded the budget by \$1,128,918. Shawmut Design and Construction has since completed the bidding process for all additional non-Trade Contractors which were net neutral to budget. It would not be advantageous to re-bid the entire project because there was very good coverage in the initial bids and because materials costs and construction prices are trending upwards. The project team performed a detailed analysis of the scope for each trade and identified a number of value engineering opportunities which reduced the total budget variance to \$796,012 above the \$34,469,807 Construction Budget. Accordingly, Shawmut Design and Construction has developed a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for completion of the entire base scope of work for the project in the amount of \$35,265,819. This calculates to \$287 per square foot which compares favorably to the cost of other recent MSBA High School projects.

The Total Project Budget of \$43,000,000 includes a Construction Contingency of \$1,723,490 which is outside of the Construction Budget. Because the GMP is greater than the Construction Budget, a budget transfer is needed from Construction Contingency to Construction. After this transfer, the remaining Construction Contingency in the Total Project Budget will be \$927,478 which is 2.6% of value of the GMP and should be reasonable for this job given that it is a CM project. The GMP includes a separate GMP Contingency of \$400,855 (1.25%) which is to cover potential additional buyout costs. The GMP also includes the "Mini-GMP" for early site, structural steel, concrete and concrete plank which totaled \$10,085,382 and which was previously approved as Amendment No. 1. The net additional contract commitment for approval herein is \$25,180,437, as outlined in the attached Amendment No. 2.

The GMP includes the budget value of \$371,473 for Waterproofing instead of a bid value because it is recommended that this trade be re-bid. The bid documents included specifications for under-slab waterproofing that upon further review by the architect and geotechnical engineer have been deemed unnecessary. We believe that re-bidding will allow the project to attain a qualified bid for the appropriate scope and within the allowance listed.

The GMP covers the entire base scope of work for the project. The GMP does not include fees for sewage connection or other utilities. The GMP does include partial rough grading of the main athletic fields because the soil materials (cuts) are necessary to build (fill) the roads and parking areas. Otherwise, the GMP does not include any alternates for athletic fields except for the Owner Hold Allowance listed below. The GMP also does not include the Alternate to change the flat roof materials from membrane to built-up roofing. As construction progresses and the risk of unanticipated expenditures is reduced, then the Town may elect to commit additional funds from Construction Contingency to include some of the finish athletic fields in the project scope.



The GMP includes an Owner Hold Allowance of \$175,000 for the balance of rough grading work for the primary athletic fields. This work does not need to be done right away, therefore the Town can evaluate the budget later in the project to determine if some or all of the scope is affordable. A condition of the GMP provides that Shawmut will not be allowed to proceed with this Hold Allowance until specifically authorized by the Town. If the Town elects not to proceed with this scope then the GMP would be adjusted down by the respective value indicated in the GMP and noted above. This Hold Allowance in effect increases the total project contingency by \$175,000 because the funds will not be expended until it is deemed prudent. This alternate will not be awarded in the subcontractors' base contract at this time, however, Shawmut will attempt to lock in the bid value with the subcontractor to the latest date possible. If this grading work is executed, the values may need to be adjusted to reflect the market conditions at that time.

BUDGET TRANSFER

The following is a budget transfer to increase funding for Construction for the GMP contract, Amendment #2, for Shawmut Design and Construction. The GMP of \$35,265,819 exceeds the line item for Construction within the Total Project Budget by \$796,012. The Budget includes \$1,723,490 in Construction Contingency, none of which has yet been committed. This transfer would shift \$796,012 from Construction Contingency to the Construction category which would leave \$927,478 in Construction Contingency. The total project cost remains within the Project Budget. Joslin Lesser recommends that the Uxbridge School Building Committee and Board of Selectmen approve this budget transfer.

Executive Summary

Shawmut Design and Construction is pleased to present the enclosed Guaranteed Maximum Price for the Uxbridge High School project. The G.M.P. is based on the contract documents (drawings and specifications) and addendums #1-9. In addition, enclosed are the following documents:

- -Amendment #2 to the contract
- -GMP cost summary
- -Allowances
- -Alternates
- -Assumptions and Clarifications
- -Drawing and specifications log
- -Schedule

We have received a strong response from the subcontractor community and have received approximately 200 bids that we have assembled, evaluated and reviewed with the OPM and A/E team to generate the GMP. Subcontractor bids were received starting on March 17, 2011 and over the past week the team has spend considerable time reviewing the contract documents a to ensure we have a complete and thorough GMP.

The current schedule indicates that the GMP is to be approved at the joint Board of Selectmen and School Building Committee meeting on March 30, 2011 to ensure that we keep track with the progress currently on site.

Based on the current schedule, we anticipate achieving substantial completion on July 27, 2012, which will allow the school bringing in furniture, equipment and other FF&E items to facilitate an opening of school for the start of Fall semester as originally scheduled.

The building permit has been received and construction activities for the Early Release Trades are currently underway and on schedule.

The current GMP (including the early release items from February) is \$35,265,819.00.

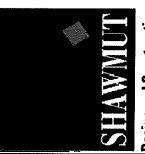

Testing services are required on large construction projects to ensure that critical work is performed according to the Bid Documents. This includes testing of concrete, masonry, steel and soils to ensure that the materials as installed demonstrate the required properties and strength and meet the specified performance requirements. The proposal for geotechnical (soils) testing was previously approved by the COWG.

To ensure the greatest flexibility and transparency in awarding to vendors, and the best value for the Town, Joslin Lesser solicited individual proposals from 5 qualified vendors for each of 3 separate testing services; Concrete, Structural Steel/Precast Plank, and Masonry. The proposals include half day and full day rates for a variety of monitoring, inspecting and testing services specific to each discipline. These rates are not consistently low for any one vendor. Therefore, to enable a fair comparison among firms, the proposals also included an estimated total fee based on a stipulated assumed scope of work (which is based on a close analysis of the project specifications and schedule).

It is not possible to precisely anticipate the number of days of testing that will be required for these services, which will be determined by the construction activities on site. Therefore the estimates below are not guaranteed totals and the actual billing will be based on the rates in the proposal for the approved vendor for each service. Joslin Lesser will monitor the work to ensure that billings are accurate and appropriate.

Please also note that some vendors included the cost of transportation to the job site in their estimated total fee and others listed that cost separately, as show in the tables below.

However, as noted above, the actual costs for these testing services are not guaranteed and will be billed on a per visit basis, not on a lump sum. There would be benefits in consistency and coordination if one vendor performs the 3 testing services. Therefore, since UTS has the lowest cost for the 2 other testing services, and the UTS estimated total cost for Concrete testing is only \$1,065 above Briggs, it is recommended that at the SBC award the contract for Concrete Rebar Inspection and Material Testing to UTS.

BID PRINTING

At the January 12th meeting the SBC approved a commitment for Bid Printing by BFS Not to Exceed \$25,000. This amount was based on an estimated average cost for similar school projects, however the actual total cost of printing for this project will exceed the current allocation. The bid process for the High School included printing of 9 addenda and sets were distributed to the large number of Trade Subcontractors who bid on the project. Raymond Design will also be producing "addendized" sets of drawings which will be distributed for project team use. The invoices presented below for BFS total \$19,356, and the sum of all previous and current BFS invoices is \$24,154. In anticipation of additional BFS invoices to be presented at future meetings, it is recommended that the SBC recommend to the BOS approval of an additional \$8,000 Not To Exceed amount for Printing. The Project Budget includes \$70,000 for Advertising and Printing so this is well within budget.

Please also note that BFS collected bid deposits from each Trade bidder in the amount of \$200 which are refundable to the bidders if they return the bid sets to BFS by April 17th. Any deposits that are remaining after the deadline will be returned to the Town (31 sets have not yet been returned). This can be used to offset some of the printing costs.
